Two brothers, one a winemaker, the other a former hotelier, opened this campsite within the grounds of their family home in 2006. It's designed to reflect and respect its rural location, so don't expect manicured grounds, but large pitches on uneven ground hedged with oleander and vines in the shade of mature green oak trees. The position of some of the trees may make it difficult to manoeuvre on to some of the pitches, unless you have a caravan mover.

Facilities

There is an emphasis on quality, as you would expect from a Castel park member, and value for money, especially in the on-site restaurant and takeaway, where the portions are large and the menu is simple. The shop is well stocked and sells the vineyard's own

wines (you can also try wine tasting). Bikes can be hired to cycle into Sommières, just over two miles away, or to Nîmes, rather more distant. There's play equipment for the children, a fitness circuit, swimming pools and flumes. There is an extra charge for the sauna, steam room and Jacuzzi. English is spoken.
